



Junk Car Figure 8 Racing Rules

General Rules - 4&6 Cylinders only. Builds must meet Small Car/ Mid Size Build Specs within Demo Derby Rule Book! This is a first time event - Lets make it FUN!

- All drivers must have DOT/Snell approved helmet & eye protection.
- All drivers will wear long sleeves, long pants, & gloves.
- **\$50 fee (Includes, Vehicle Entry, driver entry & pit band)**
- When a driver is in the vehicle, the safety belt must be fastened and all safety equipment worn.
- All vehicles must have fully functional, factory installed seat belts or be outfitted with approved racing style harnesses.
- **All competitors must have a minimum 18" x 18" roof sign that cannot strengthen the car in any way.**
- No flags or other objects protruding out from the car.
- Vehicles must be clean and free of all debris with all plastic removed.
- All glass must be removed from the vehicle. This includes doors, headlights, taillights, rear windows, & mirrors. The windshield may remain in factory location or be removed.
- All sharp edges will be removed or covered with sufficient padding to prevent injury.
- A working hydraulic operated brake system is mandatory. (No brakes means you will not run)
- NO profanity written on vehicles.
- Drivers must have a valid drivers license.
- All drivers under 18 years of age must have a signed consent form signed by parent or legal guardian at the time of registration.
- Do not move during a red flag unless directed by a track official.
- Drivers must remain in the car during the event. Drivers may exit with permission from a track official or during any red flag. Please do not exit your vehicle without being acknowledged by a track official.
- 1 fire, after the second fire your vehicle will be considered unsafe to continue and will be disqualified.
- 1 rollover, If rolled track officials will return the vehicle to all 4 wheels and the driver may continue. Following the second rollover the car is disqualified from that race/event.
- Each registrant will be allowed one tow vehicle and trailer in the pit area.
- Vehicles are subject to re-inspection at any time.
- Officials may require modifications to a vehicle at any time for safety reasons or rules.
- Drives and cars are considered one in the same. If qualifying in a heat you must run that car in the feature. No borrowing/trading cars.
- 4 cylinder & 6 cylinder may run together, depending on car counts.

Additional Rules

- 1)Wire Mesh wire must be installed over the driver's side of the windshield.
- 2)Driver's door protection is REQUIRED for racing events. A minimum 2" x 2 x 1/8" square tubing must be used. The Driver's door must be orange or a contrasting color.
- 3)Roll over protection is required and must be padded.
- 4)All racing classes must have an approved racing window net on the driver's side. No wire, snow fence, or permanent new will be permitted. It must be removable for safety purposes.
- 5)Front bumpers may be replaced if missing with a hollow square tubing no larger than 4" x 4" x 1/4" thick. It may not extend past the centerline of each tire. Front & rear bumpers can be a max of 18" high measured from the ground to the bottom of the bumper. There can only be a difference of 3" maximum between front & rear bumpers. No sharp edges allowed.
- 6)Radiator protection may be used on front bumpers. It may be no higher than 8" and no wider than the factory bumper mounts.
- 7)Side to side bars may be used behind the front seat and in place of the dash.
